On 15 April 2025 a virtual meeting was held between the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) and the Algerian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CACI), with the participation, from the Indian side, of Mr. Gautam Ghosh, Senior Director (FICCI) and Mrs. Sudeshna, Joint Director, International Affairs- MENA, SOUTH ASIA, BIMSTEC (FICCI) and from the Algerian side, the President of CACI Mr. Kamel Hamani and his Director of International Cooperation and Partnership Mr. Boualem Tarafi, and two Directors of the pharmaceutical company Saidal, Dr. Amara Younes and Mr. Noureddine Ghazi. Saidal who expressed their desire to partner with Indian entities from the field of bio-pharma and oncology. An MOU was signed between the two Chambers in 2000 and they are presently working on updating this MOU as per the actual rules and regulations. The main purpose of holding the virtual meeting was to discuss the means for the relaunch of the Joint Business Council between India and Algeria.
