Sonatrach CEO Rachid Hachichi received a delegation from the Indian company Larsen & Toubro led by the company's Deputy Managing Director and Chairman, Subramanian Sarma. The two parties discussed ways to develop their cooperation.

During this meeting the two parties discussed projects between the two companies, relating to the construction of gas processing units in the southwest of Algeria in Tinerkouk, Hassi Tidjerane, and Hassi Bahamou, which began effective gas production in 2024 and are currently completing procedures for final

acceptance. The discussions also focused on prospects for future partnerships between Sonatrach and Larsen & Toubro and ways to implement them on the ground. In this context, representatives of the Indian company expressed their strong desire to engage in Sonatrach's future projects, particularly through participation in calls for tenders.
