Pre-Qualification Criteria.

- 3.1 Only Indian Defence Public Sector Undertakings (DPSUs), Indian Defence Companies registered in India, or Institutions of National Importance (INI) shall be eligible to participate in this procurement.
- 3.2 The bidder must possess valid CMMI Level 3 or equivalent certification for software development.
- 3.3 The bidder must hold ISO/IEC 27001:2013 Information Security certification, or any other certification mandated for projects classified as Secret/Confidential by the Ministry of Defence.
- 3.4 The bidder must have successfully executed, within the last three (3) years, at least one project of equivalent scope and complexity, i.e., a strategic-level Wargaming System or Operational Planning System for the Indian Armed Forces, with documentary proof of completion.
- 3.5 Bidders must submit their Pre-Qualification bids online via email to hoc.algiers@mea.gov.in by 09 November 2025, 23:59 hrs CET.

3.6 Only those bidders whose responses are found to be compliant with all the Pre-Qualification criteria will be declared as pre-qualified and will be issued the RFP for submission of detailed Technical and Commercial bids. Bidders who do not meet the PQ criteria shall not be eligible for participation in subsequent stages of the procurement process.

Pre-Bid Meeting.

- 4.1 Qualified bidders will be issued an NDA via email to be digitally signed and emailed to Head of Chancery (HoC), Algeria.
- 4.2 Pre-bid meeting will be at the Embassy of India, Algiers, Algeria on 12 November 2025 or held on-line via Video Conference Call (VC).
- 4.3 During the pre-bid meeting, NDA will be formally signed, and the RFP will be issued to the bidders.
- 4.4 All bidders shall notify the Embassy in writing about the specific clarifications sought not later than 16 November 2025.
- 4.5 Copies of the response to queries will be sent to all prospective qualified bidders who have received the bidding documents and shall be appended to the RFP.

Additional Clause for AMC/CMC.

- 5.1 Warranty Period. The quoted price of the equipment shall include a comprehensive warranty of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance, covering preventive maintenance, calibration, service charges, and spares (excluding consumables), as per the manufacturer's service/technical manual.
- 5.2 **AMC Period.** After expiry of warranty, the seller shall provide a Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for three (3) years, covering preventive maintenance, calibration, service visits at least once every six months (or as per user requirement), and spares (excluding consumables).
- 5.3 **Uptime Guarantee.** During AMC, the seller shall ensure a minimum 98% uptime of the equipment on a 24×7×365 basis. Any downtime shall attract a penalty by extending the AMC period by double the downtime duration.
- 5.4 Cost Inclusion. The bidder shall quote the equipment cost (inclusive of 1-year warranty) and year-wise AMC charges separately for 3 years. These costs shall be inclusive of GST, transportation, insurance, boarding/lodging, incidental charges, spares, and repairs. No additional liability shall accrue on the purchaser beyond the quoted AMC charges.
- 5.5 **Payment Terms.** AMC-payments shall commence after completion of warranty and shall be made quarterly in arrears, subject to certification of satisfactory performance by the end-user/consignee.
- 5.6 Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG). The seller shall furnish a PBG for the AMC value between 2.5% to 10% as specified in the bid, valid until completion of AMC plus one (1) year. The AMC PBG shall be submitted before the warranty expires; failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the original equipment PBG.

- 5.7 Order Splitting. In case of order splitting, higher quoting eligible bidders shall be required to match both the equipment cost and year-wise AMC charges of the L1 bidder.
- 5.8 Scope of AMC. AMC shall be comprehensive in nature, including all preventive and corrective maintenance, calibration, spares, damaged parts, hand tools/tackles, and special tools required to carry out the work, excluding only consumables.

- 6.2 The Procuring Entity reserves the right to cancel/modify the tender at any time without assigning reasons.
