		million usd in the first quarter of 2019, compared to 35.13 million dollars in the same period last year, an increase of more than 61 %. Imports of live animals reached 59.09 million USD, against 48.92 million USD (+ 20.77%) during the same comparison period. This upward trend also concerned various food preparations, which rose from US \$ 67.75 million in the first quarter of 2018 to nearly US \$ 73 million in the same period of 2019 (+ 7.60%). In addition to these main products, the remaining food goods were imported for US \$ 259 million, compared to US \$ 246.61 million (+ 5.03%). Regarding soybean oil and its fractions, even refined (classified in the Group of goods intended for the operation of the production tool), their imports have decreased slightly to 156.87 million usd in the 1st quarter 2019, against	 industry, to encourage the diversification of the Algerian economy and to reduce the import bill. On these three points this policy did not reach the required results. Consequently the Algerian government is now planning to lift in the coming days the ban on imports of certain products according to the needs of the national market. Additional import duties of between 30% and 200%, which will be levied in addition to customs duties, is the new import control system which will replace the provisional import suspension of a the list of nearly 900 products. However, Algeria is still working towards developing other sectors than the hydrocarbons one. The key sectors are agriculture, manufacturing industry, mining, pharmaceutical, tourism, IT and Telecom.
